- Grandparents' Day on October 11th was a great success. We had a packed gym and a good time connecting with grandparents and their grandchildren. We continue to work at finding the best way to communicate with grandparents ahead of time and streamline the logistics of the morning. NHS students were a huge help in this event as was Amber Kilian!
- Finding subs continues to be a challenge. We could still use a few more.
- Elementary chapels <u>monthly themes</u> that tie into the whole school theme for the year of "Let Your Light Shine!"

Mrs. S told students to use "thumbs up" or "thumbs down" to represent yes or no to a couple of questions she asked. She showed a visual aid from the curriculum and read with expression the portion of the account from the Bible that they were focusing on that day. One student asked for a "sneak peek" about tomorrow and Mrs. S quickly showed them the picture card for tomorrow and said the title and then tucked it away. Old Business

· We were still trying to set up Go Guardian Teacher. We were able to set up Go Guardian Teacher but we still have issues seeing all students who are on a PC. We will continue to troubleshoot the problems. Tad and Sue worked on it some more and finally had to contact Tech Support. The video meeting has been postponed till November now.

New Business

- · The new PA system is being installed in all the buildings, in the rooms, hallways and even outside.
- · The internet has had issues. We keep troubleshooting that in the hopes of identifying and resolving the issue after the PA system is installed.
- · Several teacher and student computers crashed. Some you could only see a black screen and the arrow. Others wouldn't connect to the access points for the internet. Those particular computers had wireless USB WiFi Adapters. Turns out both were caused by an update. Mr. Grabow was able to fix the updates. And then we hard wired those computers that had the USB WiFi Adapters.
- · Mrs. Taylor's projector is very dim. We will be purchasing another TV to replace it.
- · Mrs. Adams needs a remote for her projector. We are in the process of testing out some remotes we have on hand.
- · Several teacher computers are coming to end of life. Mr. Grabow has a group of students on Wednesdays that are working with hardware and he plans to build some computers with them to use for the school. This would save money to build them than to purchase them.
